WINDOWS 7 SUPPORT ENDS

With Microsoft ending support for their Windows 7 operating system on 14 January 2020, Windows 7 users must decide what they will do.

There are two main options:

1. Change to Windows 10, either by buying a new computer or upgrading your Windows 7 machine to Windows 10, if the existing hardware is suitable.
2. Continue to use your Windows 7 computer but disconnect it from the internet – it will continue to work fine. You will then need another device (eg: old laptop, tablet or smartphone) to access web-based services like web browsing and email.

A new Windows 10 PC will provide the most secure and satisfying outcome.
