James Kelly from Owen Hodge Lawyers gave an entertaining and informative presentation on some of the legal issues involved with retirement villages, a topic that had been prominent in the media that week.



James emphasised the importance of seeking legal advice to understand the financial implications of moving into a retirement village. In particular, entry costs, ongoing monthly fees and exit fees all need to be carefully considered.

The following cooling off periods apply:

- 14 days before documents can be signed,
- 7 days after documents are signed and
- 90 days after moving in.
