20 YEARS IN 20 LINES

A meeting on 29 April 1998, convened by Mr George Thompson and attended by 80 people, resulted in the formation of Hurstville Seniors Computer Club.

The Club's first monthly newsletter, outlining the proposed areas for tutoring and support, was published in July 1998.

At the AGM in August 2002, Councillor Merv Lynch, an enthusiastic supporter of the Club's activities, became our Patron.

By 2004, special interest groups were formed and have continued to flourish ever since.

Over the years our areas of tuition and support have had to expand from the earliest Windows-based desktop computers to cater for members' developing interests in laptops, tablets and smartphones and new operating systems.

Our affiliation with ASCCA has provided access to excellent training opportunities and administrative support.
