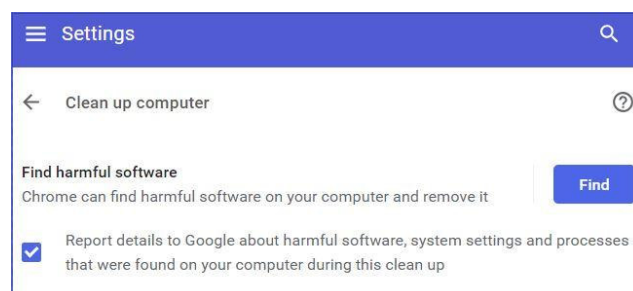
### CHROME CLEANUP

Sometimes when you download software or other content, it may be bundled with other unwanted software, without your knowledge, as part of the installation process,.

The Google Chrome browser includes a cleanup tool which detects and alerts you to unsolicited changes to your Chrome browser, including:

- Pop-up ads and new tabs that won't go away,
- Your Chrome homepage or search engine keeps changing without your permission,
- Unwanted Chrome extensions or toolbars keep coming back,
- Your browsing is hijacked, and redirects to unfamiliar pages or ads, or
- Alerts about a virus or an infected device.

To run a manual scan from your Chrome browser, type "chrome://settings/cleanup" in the browser address bar and press 'Enter'. Then, click the 'Find' button.
