KEEPING THE SCROLL BAR

In order to prevent scroll bars from hiding automatically in Windows 10, make the following changes in Settings:

- Settings > Ease of Access > Display
- Under “Simplify and personalise Windows”, switch “Automatically hide scroll bars in Windows” to Off.

At this month’s meeting, Mary Bills, a Project Officer from COTA NSW (Council on the Ageing) will show us how to navigate the services available from My Aged Care.



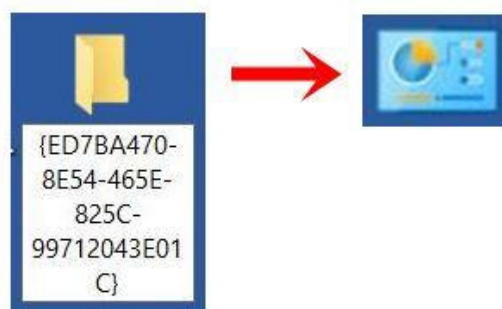
“GOD MODE” IN WINDOWS 10

God Mode conveniently collects most of Windows’ admin, management, settings, and Control Panel tools in a single, easy-to-scroll-through interface.

To access it, right-click on the desktop and select New > Folder, then rename this folder as

GodMode.{ED7BA470-8E54-465E-825C-99712043E01C}

Simply double-click on the God Mode folder to display over 200 settings tools, and then double-click on any tool to open it.
